








Health Sciences Building

GROUND FLOOR





Parking

- · Most parking meters on campus are
 - \$3.00 per hour 7:30 AM to 6 PM Monday to Friday
 - \$1.50 per hour 6 PM to 10 PM Monday to Friday
 - \$1.50 per hour 7: 30 AM to 10 PM Saturdays.
- All meters at Royal University Hospital locations are in operation 24 hours (year-round).
- The Health Sciences Parkade is a visitor lot open to the public at \$3.00 per hour with no daily maximum.
- G lot, located on Science Crescent, After 4 pm, patrons can use for \$6.00 per exit per day and all day on weekends.
- Summer parking is from May 1 to August 31. Free parking on weekdays after 4 PM and all day on weekends in Staff and Student Lots.
